



Zulu Records hosts Rock Photography

Pere Ubu. Redd Kross. Afghan Whigs. Anyone with ears on in the late 1980s coveted these bands and probably caught their live shows in seedy hell-holes for \$5. Vancouver photographer Derek von Essen hauled his camera to nearly every "haven't heard of 'em" gig you should have been to, including Nirvana (that's late icon Kurt Cobain pictured) at a criminally empty Lee's Palace in Toronto (Oct. 16, 1990). "Cobain jumped off the stage to sing at the handful of people sitting at the front tables," recalls von Essen. 88: Rock Photography from 1988-1993 opens at Zulu Records, Saturday.
